Would you think twice about speaking in His name? You know and I know that if we are living our lives according to God's word, it would hurt to hold back the gospel from others.

If you don't feel that fire shut up in your bones, there are only two parties responsible for that fire. Either you or God is the one keeping that fire out of your life. I know for sure it is not God's fault, so do the Math. If you are able to hold back speaking His word, maybe the fire is not lit hot enough inside of you! This raises two questions, "What are you going to do about it?" and "How can we help?"
