The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation Opens a New Free Vision Clinic in Adam's Park Herber Hoover Boys & Girls Club

October 15, 2007...St. Louis, MO- The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation has provided children with over 600 free comprehensive eye exams and over 500 free pairs of glasses since the opening of the Clarkson Eyecare Free Vision Clinic at the Herbert Hoover Boys and Girls Club (HHBGC) in November 2003. They will now be able to do even more with the Grand Opening in the Adam's Park Boys & Girls Club.

On October 22, the Clarkson Eyecare Foundation will host a ribbon cutting to officially open their new space at the HHBGC-Adam's Park. Since the opening of the original clinic, children in the metro St. Louis area who otherwise might have not been able to receive it, have gained access to comprehensive eye care services and vision improvement. "So many young people do not receive proper vision care. Together, The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation and Herbert Hoover are working to combat this problem and give kids a bright future," said Flint Fowler, Executive Director of the Herbert Hoover Boys and Girls Club. Volunteer Doctors and staff from Clarkson Eyecare administer eye examinations at the Club on a weekly basis, providing glasses if needed.

The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation is committed to improving access to vision care through eye care services, education and research. It exists to provide eye health services to underprivileged and specific-need individuals through programs such as the Free Vision Clinic.
