Clarkson Eyecare Foundation Joins Pujols Family Foundation in the Dominican Republic

February 18, 2008, St. Louis, MO- The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation recently joined forces with the Pujols Family Foundation from February 3-9, 2008. A team of 20 people including three doctors, six opticians, translators, helpers, and Albert and Deedee Pujols traveled to the Dominican Republic. The team was able to see over 1800 people and provide over 300 pairs of glasses to those less fortunate in villages and orphanages. The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation donated the proper equipment, eye wear, and supplies to aid in this mission trip.

The team visited the most remote areas of the Dominican Republic, including Orfanato Niño's de Cristo (The Children of Christ Orphanage) and Batey Aleman. The team also included a pediatrician who administered vaccinations and medical care as needed.

The Clarkson Eyecare Foundation plans on returning to the Dominican Republic with the Pujols Family Foundation in 2010 to provide even more children and families in need with a better quality of life.
