



Independent AMBA road test of the Marco Sky L tandem stroller

Kalie Green and her two year old twins live in Rockhampton. Here Kalie talks to AMBA about the Marco Sky L.

AMBA - What do you love about the Marco Sky L?

Kalie - The handling is brilliant; it is compact, narrow and very light. It is easy to fold up and down and easy to manoeuvre in and out of our Astra. Also, the twins like being in it. My two are quite tall for their age and both sit comfortably in the pram at 19 months.

AMBA - How does the Marco Sky L handle in different terrains?

Kalie - I have mainly used it at shopping centres and visiting parks, but handled really well and easy to push on grass. My father even commented on how light it was to push.

AMBA - Any negatives?

Kalie - Maroon colour- hard to see my kids in it when I am a NSW supporter! The 'basket' is very small and I ended up moving it under the feet of the highest seat as the kids kept throwing things down there and this would catch it. But I bought a clip on bag from Big W that I can put things in I would usually throw in the basket. I was worried my two would pull each other's hair etc, but they really like being in the stroller.

AMBA - Who and why you recommend it to a buyer?

Kalie - I'd recommend it to parents of twins who don't need both seats reclining, who need more space in their boot for groceries instead of prams, and especially to Mums with two kids or more and put the smaller child in the back so it can recline and not have things thrown on it!

AMBA - Any other comments?

Kalie - I get LOTS of comments about it, and everyone at twin club just marvels at it, especially the ones with school-aged kids now - "That's so much better than the tandems we used to have!" gets said A LOT. The Marco Sky L is fantastic - suits us perfectly.
