

## RECREATION COMMISSION OCTOBER 5, 2009

### MINUTES:

Ms. Martin made a motion to approve the September 14, 2009 minutes, seconded by Mr. Adams. All present members voted "aye" to approve.

### SUMMER RECREATION:

Mr. Cain shared summer recreation prices from area towns.

Town of Macedon, 6 wk program Town of Canandaigua, 6 wk program  
1 child \$240.00 wk 1 child \$50.00 wk  
2 children \$450.00 wk family \$100.00 wk  
3 children \$660.00 wk

Town of Honeoye Falls/Mendon, 6 wk program Town of Perinton, 6 wk program  
1 child K-3 \$150.00 season 1 child \$240.00 per 2 wks  
Older children \$180.00 season

Town of Manchester, 6 wk program Town of Farmington, 6 wk program  
1 child \$100.00 wk 1 child \$75.00 resident, \$95.00 non resident  
Family \$110.00 residents, \$140.00 non resident

The Recreation members discussed increasing the cost of summer recreation. The increase will be \$75.00 to \$95.00 per resident/child \$110.00 to \$160.00 per resident/family  
\$95.00 to \$125.00 non resident/child \$140.00 to \$200.00 non resident/family

Registration will be open to Farmington residents May 17, 18, open registration May 26, 27 and registration will close on June 11.

### BUDGET:

The members discussed the budget. The Town Board increased the budget by 2% over last years budget. Mr. Schwarzweller will ask Mr. Fafinski for a copy of the approved budget.

The members discussed opening up Farmington Grove Park. The Farmington Town Board stated that the Recreation Board has to show an increased revenue to open the park.

The members discussed how many employees they would need for each park. Mr. Cain said that there needs to be 35 summer employees, 10 leaders, 24 assistants, 1 director.

FALL PARTY:

The Recreation Commission will hold a fall party on November 15, 2009 from 1:00 to 3:00 with cider and donuts at Mertensia Lodge.

The members will look at dates they would like to reserve the lodge next year. These dates can be reserved starting January 2010. They will discuss the possibility of holding the Easter Egg Hunt there.
