

Toxics Use Reduction Reporting Workshop

What does TURA mean for my shop? Dry cleaners that have 10 or more full time employee equivalents and use 1,000 pounds (about 75 gallons) or more of perc are required to file an annual toxics use report, pay a toxics use fee, and eventually prepare a toxics use reduction plan. This workshop will focus on the first reporting required by July 1, 2010.

Wednesday - April 28, 2010, 4:00 - 6:00PM

Bridgewater State College, East Campus Commons, Room 113 (Executive Dining Room)

- *From the North:* I-93 to Route 24 South
- *From the West:* Mass Pike (I-90) to I-495 South to Exit 7A (Route 24 North)
- *From the South:* Follow I-495 North to Exit 7A (Route 24 North)

From Route 24:

- Go to Exit 15 (Bridgewater/Raynham - Route 104)
- Take Route 104 East to stop sign (approximately three miles)
- Turn left and approach rotary in Bridgewater Center
- Proceed to rotary, stay in right lane within rotary.
- Just before traffic light, bear right merging on to Summer Street (Route 104 East).
- Bear left through traffic light (Mobil station on left).
- Go over railroad tracks.
- Take right on to Hooper Street.
- Follow Hooper Street to the end and take a left on to Burrill Avenue.
- Visitor parking is in the Moakley Lot (Lot Q), just past the Moakley Center on the left.

UMass Lowell/Wannalancit – 600 Suffolk St. MIL Room 1st floor

- *From Greater Boston:* Take Route 3 North to Exit 30B to the *Lowell Connector*.
- *From North or South:* Take exit 35C to the *Lowell Connector*.

From the Lowell Connector:

- Take Exit 5B (off the Lowell Connector) - Thorndike Street.
- Turn RIGHT at the end of ramp (no other choice) onto Thorndike.
- Continue on this street until you are in front of the entrance to the Tsongas Arena. Take a LEFT onto Fr. Morrisette Blvd.
- Take RIGHT onto Suffolk Street.
- The Wannalancit Building is immediately on your left.
- The visitors' parking lot is on the right.
- Enter at 600 Suffolk St. – the entrance at the corner of Fr. Morrisette and Suffolk St.

- *From Boston or East of Rt. 495:* Massachusetts Turnpike to Rt. 495 North to Rt. 290 West to Rt. 190 North to Exit 1 West Boylston Street – North 1 mile to campus (on right).
- *From Springfield or West:* Massachusetts Turnpike to Rt. 290 East to Rt. 190 North ½ mile to Exit 1 West Boylston Street – North 1 mile to campus (on right).
- *From Lowell or North:* Rt. 495 to Rt. 2 West to Rt. 190 South to Exit 4 West Boylston Street, South 1 ½ miles to campus.
