



Summer Fun At ECAG

July 18

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that the things they think, say and do should please God.
- Main Point: Goodness: I Will Please God In What I Think, Say and Do!
- Bible Story: David is anointed to be king. (1 Samuel 16)
- Memory Verse: "The Lord approves of those who are good, but he condemns those who plan wickedness" (Proverbs 12:2 NLT).

July 25

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that they should be faithful and do what they say they will do.
- Main Point: Faithfulness: I Will Do What I Say I Will Do!
- Bible Story: David fights Goliath. (1 Samuel 17)
- Memory Verse: "I have chosen to be faithful; I have determined to live by your regulations" (Psalm 119:30 NLT)

August 1

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that we should think of what God wants us to do before we act.
- Main Point: Self-control: I Will Think Of What God Wants Me To Do Before I Act.
- Bible Story: David spares Saul's life. (1 Samuel 26)
- Memory Verse: "A person without self-control is like a city with broken down walls" (Proverbs 25:28 NLT).

August 8

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that patience means waiting without complaining.
- Main Point: Patience: I Will Wait Without Complaint.
- Bible Story: David patiently waits for his son to build the Temple (1 Chronicles 22)
- Memory Verse: "Rejoice in our confident hope. Be patient in trouble, and keep on praying" (Romans 12:12 NLT).

August 15

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that joy is based on God's love for us, not our circumstances.
- Main Point: Joy: I Will Be Joyful Because God Loves Me.
- Bible Story: The Ark of God is returned to Jerusalem and David celebrates. (2 Samuel 6)
- Memory Verse: "Always be joyful" (1 Thessalonians 5:16 NLT).

August 22

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that God wants us to be kind and gentle with each other.
- Main Point: Kindness and Gentleness: I Will Treat Others The Way God Would Want Me to Treat Them.
- Bible Story: David shows kindness to Mephibosheth. (2 Samuel 9)
- Memory Verse: "Your love has given me much joy and comfort, my brother, for your kindness has often refreshed the hearts of God's people" (Philemon 1:7 NLT).

August 29

September 5

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that we can have peace if we trust in God when times are hard.
- Main Point: Peace: I Trust God in Difficult Times.
- Bible Story: David writes songs of peace. (Psalms 3; 23)
- Memory Verse: "I am leaving you with a gift peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid" (John 14:27 NLT).

September 12

- Lesson Goal: The children will learn that love is shown by the things we choose to do.
- Main Point: Love: We Show Love By Our Actions.
- Bible Story: Jesus showed His love for us when He died for us on the cross. (Luke 23; 24)
- Memory Verse: "But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners" (Romans 5:8 NLT).
