2011 PHRF Fall Series Yacht Races

Notice of Race

August 7, 2011

1.0 Organizing Authority:

- 1.1 The Cape Fear Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority of this series.

2.0 Rules:

- 2.1 Races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions.

3.0 Eligibility and Entry:

- 3.1 The Series is open to all self-righting mono-hull boats 20 feet LOA or longer. The owner shall be the Captain of the vessel
- 3.2 In the event the Captain can not be aboard a competing boat for a series race, the Captain may designate a provisional Captain to preserve the eligibility of the boat in the series.
- 3.3 All competing boats must comply with US Sailing and US Coast Guard safety standards and regulations, be suitable for the competition and have an operational Marine VHF radio on board.

4.0 Schedule of Races:

Starting times may be modified by the sailing instructions.

Races may be postponed due to weather or other conditions – make up dates to be determined and posted on the CFYC web page seven days before the date. A make up race may be held on the same date as another race.

5.0 Ratings:

- 5.1 All boats competing must have a valid NCPHRF rating, or promptly apply for the same.
- 5.2 Boats not having a current NCPHRF rating shall be assigned a provisional rating by the Race Committee. Once a NCPHRF rating is obtained the boat's scores shall be changed for the Series to reflect the rating obtained.

6.0 Fleets:

- 6.1 Boats entered in the Series may be assigned to a Fleet by the Race Committee.

7.0 Entry procedure:

- 7.1 Any boat competing in the Series must submit a registration form prior to competing.
- 7.2 A registration form shall be submitted prior to the conclusion of the Competitor's meeting.
- 7.3 Late entries are allowed by completing and submitting a registration form prior to competing to the Race Committee or Cape Fear Yacht Club at 4791 Fish Factory Road, Oak Island, NC 28465.
- 7.4 Late entries shall not be accepted after the start of the second race in the Series.

8.0 Sailing Instructions:

- 8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Competitor's Meeting.

9.0 Registration fees:

- 9.1 The entry fee is \$35.00 for members of CFYC.
- 9.2 The entry fee is \$100.00 for non-members of CFYC.
- 9.2 US SAILING members receive a discount of \$5.00.

10.0 Scoring:

- 10.1 Boats must receive scores (other than DNC) in a minimum of 3 races to complete the series.
- 10.2 Participants will be scored on the best 3 races.
- 10.3 Scoring will utilize Time on Time handicapping.

11.0 Inspection and Measurement:

- 11.1 All boats are subject to random inspection at any time during the Series.

12.0 Racing area:

- 12.1 Ocean races will be conducted on Long Bay, the Atlantic Ocean in the Bald Head Island, Oak Island vicinity.
- 12.2 River races will be conducted on the Cape Fear River in the Southport, Oak Island, and Bald Head Island vicinity.

13.0 Awards:

- 13.1 Awards will be presented for the first, second and third place in each Fleet.
