NCCCO Timeline:

Completed Written Exam applications are due approximately 3 weeks prior to exam date. Applications that are submitted after deadline are subject to late fee.

Training (optional) consists of 2-days classroom to prepare candidate for written exam and is typically completed the 2-days prior to written exam.

Written Exam is administered by a representative of NCCCO. The exam starts at 8:00 AM and takes approximately 4 hours for a candidate that is taking the Core Exam and two specialties. There are four mobile crane specialties. Candidates must take at least one specialty, but can take all four. The specialties are as follows:

- Small Telescopic (fixed cab)
- Large Telescopic (swing cab)
- Lattice Boom Crawler
- Lattice Boom Truck

Written Exam results are received approximately 10 working days after the exam. Detailed results are mailed directly to candidate's home address.

Practical Exams are typically completed the 2-days preceding the written exam. The practical exam applications, along with passport photos, are completed on the day of the practical exam.

Practical Exam results are received approximately 10 working days after the exam. Once a candidate has passed both the written & practical testing in the chosen crane categories, certification card will be mailed to candidate's home address.
