All Band personnel will have their hand stamped and will not need to pay admission. Field access passes will be distributed by Mr. Chester prior to warm-up. Because there is a restriction to the number of field passes that can be given out we ask that you please bring extra money for admission.

Call Time: 8:30 AM CDT (This means on the field ready to go with instrument and equipment. The hall will open at 7:15 AM CDT). Rehearsal will occur from 8:30 AM CDT until 9:30 AM CDT.

Dress: Hillwood Band Formal Dress Uniform – Color Guard – Competition Uniform
Students must wear appropriate undergarments under the uniform. The following are required for the formal dress uniform:

Color Guard – Competitive Uniform. Please wear conservative and appropriate undergarments for the type and style of this uniform.

Band: Undershirt – **Black Under Armour shirt only.** Tank tops, halter tops, etc. will not be acceptable and will warrant suspension from the performance. **Do not wear long sleeve Under Armour Shirts.**

Underwear - all students must wear form fitted underwear. Briefs, boxer briefs, biker shorts are acceptable. **BOXER SHORTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

Socks- ALL STUDENTS MUST WEAR BLACK SOCKS THAT ARE MID-CALF IN LENGTH. **Ankle length socks are unacceptable.**

You will not need casual uniforms for these events! The reason for this is because we will remain in halves from Glencliff to Westmoreland. At Westmoreland we are the last band on and we will remain in uniform for Westmoreland High School Band’s performance. When we get back to the busses following awards at Westmoreland you may change into whatever clothing (school and weather appropriate) you choose.

It is of extreme importance that NO PARENTS come to the field before, during, or after the retreat ceremonies. The commanding officers of the band program have been instructed on how to handle themselves during and after retreat ceremonies. In year's past we have had several parents walk out onto the field before, during, and after retreat ceremonies. Please help us maintain our professional image by not walking out onto the field during this ceremony. We certainly encourage parents to take pictures and there are plenty of vantage points to do this from without walking out onto the field. Let us all celebrate our successes together back at our busses rather than in a spectacle on the field.

Dismissal will be from Hillwood High School. **Once busses are thoroughly inspected for cleanliness, ALL EQUIPMENT has been put away, and the rehearsal hall cleaned we will dismiss together.** Please do not plan on leaving immediately upon our return to Hillwood High School. We will always dismiss all students together once final announcements have been made from the rehearsal hall.

Ladies: Please note that all jewelry and make-up is prohibited. The only ladies that may wear make-up will be the color guard (please check with Mr. Chester for more information on what is and what is not acceptable). Please be advised that any and all information is subject to change at a moments notice. In such instances every attempt will be made to keep you updated.

- Please feel free to bring snacks and drinks for these performances.
- Please feel free to bring extra clothes in case it gets cold. Bring rain gear because it might rain.
- Bleacher seats are very, very uncomfortable. Please feel free to bring pillows and blankets.
- Please bring money for concession stand snacks and souvenirs. There will be DVD's of our individual performance as well as programs, t-shirts, etc.

Please remember proper etiquette while watching other bands perform. Often times parents, directors and their designated staff from different band programs will sit in different sections of the stadium to get a different vantage point during the performance and not in their designated band area. Please do not say anything or do anything that would bring negative attention to our band program at Hillwood. Remember that we must hold ourselves to a higher standard because you never know who might be sitting near you. Because we are a class act organization please remember that all of the students, regardless of which band they represent, have worked very hard for this moment and for this opportunity to demonstrate what they have learned in band. Please show your admiration and respect for the students, their parents, their staff, and their directors with your enthusiastic applause and support.


