The same percentage of Americans rejects the notion that the language in the Pledge and Declaration of Independence must change with the times. - A vast 84% of Americans believe it is important to have references to God in the Pledge and the Declaration.
- Right now, 68% of Americans believe that citizenship should only be granted to those who genuinely embrace American culture and values.
- We must insist on courts that follow the facts of American history in interpreting the Constitution. This way, we can reestablish the right of every American to publicly acknowledge our Creator, as the source of our rights, our wellbeing, and our wisdom, as it is set forth in the Declaration of Independence.
- We must challenge the entrenched education bureaucracy that seeks to rewrite and secularize American history. We must challenge teachers and professors who are radically anti-American. We must review school textbooks to ensure that students are being taught factually and not some radical reinterpretation or bias that distorts America and defames our society.
