## Topic Selections

### Captivated by Christ:

Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 5:16 - *"What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: 'I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.'"* God's love captivates us, holds us together, drawing us close as beloved daughters. We are invited to come away with Jesus. Welcome!

### Serving by Christ's Example:

Jesus says in John 13:14 - *"Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet."*

- Love that goes upward is **worship**.
- Love that goes outward is **affection**.
- Love that stoops is **grace**.

### Speaking and Living Under the Gift of Christ's Grace:

In I Peter 3:4, it is written, *"Instead, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight."* A woman with Christ's spirit lives and speaks through Christ's grace with purpose, laughter, gentleness, and compassion.

### Knowing the Holy Spirit through Christ:

Paul writes in Romans 5:5 - *"...and hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out His love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us."* Let us live in the power of the Holy Spirit.

### Sharing Christ in Everyday Encounters:

To the woman at the well in John 4:14-15, Jesus said, *"...but whoever drinks of the water I shall give him shall never thirst. And the woman said, 'Sir, give me this water, so I will not be thirsty.'"* Live in your community as one who carries the Living Water for all who are thirsty.

### Living in Christ's Joy:

In John 15:11, Jesus says, *"I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete."* Living the Christian life is pure joy! Claim it.

### Leaving Christ's Footprints on the Hearts of This Generation:

The Psalmist says in Psalm 71:18b, *"O God, do not forsake me, until I declare Thy strength to this generation, Thy strength to all who are to come."* Some are being led nearer to the heart of God through the steps you are taking and by the footprints you are making.
