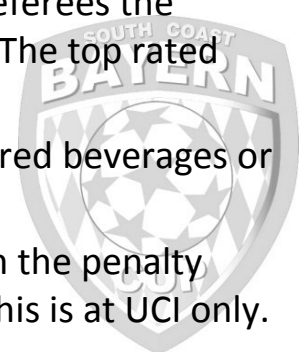

Check your team in at your game site, be at your site, 75 to 90 minutes prior to your first game.

Games for all Girls U8 to U16 and Boys U9 will be at University of California Irvine, parking \$7.

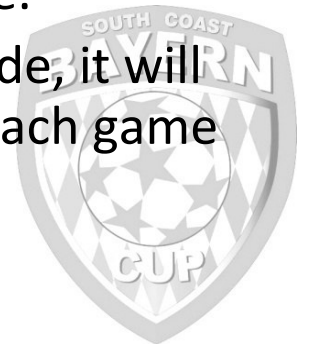
Boys U8, U10, U14 and U15 at JSerra High School in San Juan Capistrano, parking \$5.

Boys U12, U13 will be playing at the Huntington Beach Site.

- Have your administrators book in alphabetical order, player medical releases
- Place Player ID Cards in Alphabetical order
- Traveling from another country, state or AYSO have your travel papers
- Look for the Quiksilver Tents at your site to perform the Team Check-in, be there 75 to 90 minutes before your first game on Saturday July 5th. Keep in mind traffic.
- You will receive your administrators bag at check-in, gifts for your team, and your tournament booklet.
- If you pre-ordered Tournament T-Shirts you will receive them at Check In. Pre-order for \$8 each from the Bayern Cup Store.

Bayern Cup Team PRE-GAME Check-In Procedures

Each location has slightly different procedures to check your team in before your each game – Check your team in for each game with your field marshal. Have your team in uniform to team in with the field marshal 30 minutes before your game.

UCI - Each field will have a Field Marshal Tent, check in your team at your game field. Look for the tent and your staff member in a light blue Quiksilver shirt.

JSerra – Pre-game check in with the Marshal on your field.

Huntington Beach Site – The Main Check-in Area will do your pre-game check in, look for Quiksilver field MarshallTent.

Long Beach State – Pre-game check in with the Field Marshal on your field.

If you make the semi-finals or finals you will need to fill out a game card, we will have those available at each site.

- Have your team administrator or coach take the team to the Field Marshal Tent to check in the team before each game.
- Game cards are with the Field Marshal at your field
- Have your players in uniform
- Have your game card
- Have your player ID cards
- Home team is listed first
Home team supplies game ball, chooses side of field and receives kick off
- Home team (listed first)to change jerseys in case of color conflict
- If you pre-ordered Water/PowerAde it will be available to you at your field, only \$40 for all three games (72 bottles of your chilled beverage), you must order this online by July 1st

Bayern Cup Team POST-GAME Procedures

Make sure your scores are correct on the game cards and that the game card goes back to the field marshal.

We will make scores available at the site and online, please call Tournament Scorer Adrienne or score disputes or updates. (949) 322-5362.

Players need to be hydrated and enjoying nutritious snacks or meals after each game.

Have your players stretch and relax in between games, if you are leaving look around to make sure you have all your belongings.

Bring a tent for your team gather together in between each game. If you leave the site, make sure you allow enough time to get back, park and make it back to the field 45 minutes before each game.

If you lose something, we will have a lost and found online service, go to Tournament Pages on the South Coast Bayern website for more information.

- Have your coach or team administrator sign your game card after each game.
- Note the score as correct
- Game Card goes back to Field Marshall or Field Marshall Tent at your location
- Retrieve your player ID cards from the referee
- Players or coaches that receive red cards will have an automatic one game suspension and the team will lose 1 point in your player standings.
- Coaches that receive a red card will not be able to coach any team in the Bayern Cup for the rest of that day.
- Players, coaches or parents that receive a violent red card will be out of the tournament, there will be no exceptions. Zero tolerance policy in effect.
- We will have a Fair Play Award for the team with the best behavior at the Bayern Cup.

Bayern Cup Rules

In addition, bonus points shall be awarded for goals scored in a game, not to exceed a maximum of three goals per game. One additional bonus point shall be awarded to the winning team for achieving a shutout. No shutout bonus shall be awarded for a 0-0 tie.

Teams shall be awarded the bonus points for goals scored without regard to the outcome of the game. That is, the losing team will receive points for goals scored, and 0 points for the loss.

One point will be deducted for each red card received. Player and or Coach included.

Shootouts as tie breakers if all other elements are tied.

- **A.** Each team shall designate a representative who will appear in person at check in to:
 - 1) Present LAMINATED player ID cards.
 - 2) Verify the completed Player Roster
 - 3) Present completed 2007-2008 Medical Release forms signed by player's parent.
- NOTE: All teams will use 2007-2008 ID cards
- **B.** All games will be played by FIFA Rules modified by USYSA and CYSA-South. U17 through U19 International Brackets will be played strictly by FIFA Rules with the Friendly 5 rule in effect. The Friendly 5 rule limits the number of substitutions to five (5) per team per game.
- **C.** All teams will be scheduled for at least 3 games. Check your team's schedule and the list of the fields and maps. It is possible you may be playing at more than one venue. All teams from CYSA-S must have a carded coach with LAMINATED USYSA/CYSA-S sanctioned ID cards card on the sidelines during games.
- **D.** All games will be considered final and no protests will be allowed.
- **E.** The length of all U8/U9/U10 50 minute games. U11 to 13, 50 minute games. U14 to U19 games will be 60 minutes. All tournament games have 5 minutes half time.
- **F.** Championship Games for U8/U9/U10 will be 25 minute halves. U11-U13 30 minute halves. U14 to U19, will be 35 minute halves. There will be a 5 minute halftime in Championship games.
- Teams must be on opposite sides of the playing field. Home team will have choice of sides. In the event of a color conflict, home team must change jerseys. Home team will supply the game ball.
- Win = 6 points
- Tie = 3 points
- Loss = 0 points
- Shutout = 1 point

Bayern Cup Rules

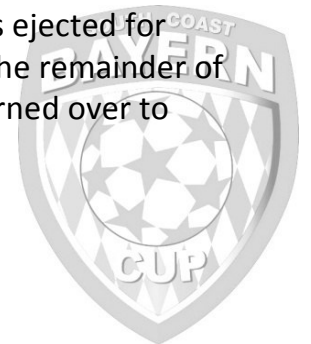
PLAYER SAFETY

1. No player will be allowed to play with an injury which could be aggravated by playing or which, in the opinion of the referee, institutes a danger to themselves or others.
2. No player wearing an orthopedic cast, temporary cast, [NON-ORALBRACE (SUCH AS KNEES OR OTHER AREAS OF THE BODY) WITH HARD, HINGED OR RIGID SUPPORTS,] or splint will not be permitted to play.
3. Shin guards are mandatory for all players.

Under 8/9/10 Procedures

1. U8 and U9 will play with a maximum of seven (7) field players **plus** a goalie on the field for a total of eight (8) players per team. A minimum of five (5) players is required.
2. U10 will play with eleven (11) players, including the goalie, on the field.
3. Opposing players must be at least eight (8) yards away on all free kicks.
4. Penalty kicks shall be ten yards from the goal line.

- A team, which "wins on a forfeit", shall be deemed to have won by a score of 1-0 and will receive 8 points.
- **J. Tie Breaker** - In the event that two or more teams are tied in points at the end of the preliminary games, the following tiebreakers shall be applied in order given until a winner is determined.
 1. Winner of head to head competition.
 2. Net goals (goals for, minus goals against).
 3. Goals against.
 4. Most goals scored (maximum of 4 goals per game).
 5. Most total wins.
 6. Most Shutout wins.
 7. Red/Yellow Cards against (Team with most will be eliminated).
 8. FIFA penalty kicks.
- **K. Semi-Final Games** - All semi-final games ending in a tie shall go directly to FIFA penalty kicks.
- **L. Championship Game** - If a game is tied at the end of regulation time, then we will play two 10 minute overtime periods and switch directions at the 10 minute mark. If the game remains tied, FIFA penalty kicks will determine the winner.
- **M.** Any player or coach receiving a RED CARD is disqualified for the remainder of the match and next match thereafter, this includes a RED CARD received for double yellow. If a player or Coach is ejected for assault then the player or coach shall be ineligible for the remainder of the tournament and their administrator card will be turned over to their respective State Association

Bayern Cup Rules

6. All yellow cards, red card ejections, and other disciplinary actions involving players, coaches, spectators or team will be reported to their appropriate state association(s).

FIFA Fair Play Award

Referees will vote for teams for the FIFA FAIR PLAY AWARD.

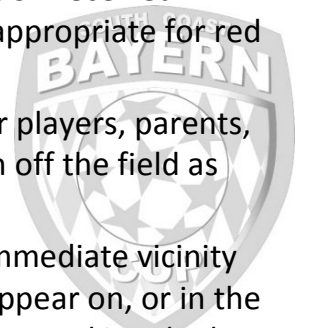
Referee Awards

Coaches and Managers will vote for the referee of the tournament for each age group. Fill out the form and turn it in to the field marshal.

All disputes are final by the authority of the Tournament Director Only.

Teams that show disregard for rules will not be invited back to future Bayern Cup Events.

- **Inclement Weather**
- A match is defined as 50% (half-time) completed
- **Sportsmanship and Standard of Play**
- A committee has been established to handle all disciplinary matters pertaining to this tournament. The following is a brief outline of what will be expected of all players and coaches who participate in this year's tournament. If you need any assistance, contact the Field Marshal at your field. Tournament Director has final say in all grievances. No games shall be played under protest for any reason.
- 1. All players and coaches will be expected to demonstrate the highest standard of sportsmanship throughout the tournament.
- 2. Any player given a red card, or any coach ejected from a game will not be permitted to participate in the remainder of the game in progress, and will not be able to participate in at least the teams next scheduled game. The Disciplinary Committee will decide if there will be any additional game suspensions. This committee will have complete authority to decide, after the initial game, the number of games a player or coach will be suspended for each red card offense. A referee report (written or verbal) will be used whenever possible to help determine final conclusions. These judgments will be made after reviewing the severity of the offense for which the red card was given and the decision will be final.
- 3. One point will be deducted for each red card/ejection received. A team may be assessed negative points for a game if appropriate for red cards.
- 4. All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players, parents, and friends while the team is at the tournament both off the field as well as on the field.
- 5. No alcoholic beverages shall be permitted in the immediate vicinity of the playing site. No person shall be permitted to appear on, or in the vicinity of, the playing site in an intoxicated condition. Breaking the law is under the jurisdiction of the Anaheim Police Department, not the tournament management team.
