Dear Friends,

A big THANK YOU is in order for this great church. In a matter of just two weeks I have encountered the heights of rest and relaxation AND the depths of dog tiredness. Our kids (and grandkid) came out to visit. We rode the ferry, visited Galveston, shopped (a little), ate (a lot), and basically did our best to recuperate from several months of packing, moving and unpacking. It was wonderful. Thank you, RHUMC for allowing us that time to rest.

We were back home for about 12 hours before I left again – this time to assist two of our adults with a Jr. High Mission trip. Jasper, TX (where I once served) was our destination; JUMMP (Jr. High United Methodist Mission Projects) was our sponsor. Trust me folks, it was no vacation.

Yet, despite the heat and the long hours, working with those adults and Jr. High students was equally refreshing to the soul. And to think, that I almost declined the invitation to go. It turned out to be a great week of spiritual nurturing and service in the name of our Lord.

There are times when we all need to renew body and soul. Renewing the body – at least for this preacher – means doing absolutely nothing. Renewing the soul means serving the Lord in word and deed.

The Bible certainly supports this kind of body/soul renewal. In Ex. 23.12, Moses writes: **"Six days do your work, but on the 7th day do not work, so that your ox and your donkey may rest..."** If our ox and donkey need rest, so do we.

The Psalmist writes, **"Be at rest once more, O my soul, for the Lord has been good to you"** (Ps 116.7). There is a time for soul resting, too. I find such rest often on mission trips. I certainly did this past week. The Lord has been good to me. So again, I say, "Thanks, RHUMC, for allowing me to serve my Lord in mission."

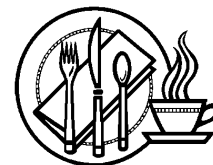
BLESSING OF THE BACKPACKS

- Must be able to be CPR certified within 45 days of start date.

- Caring for children ages newborn to age 3 on Sunday mornings
- Caring for children ages newborn to older school age for evening meetings
- Maintaining a clean and safe nursery setting for the children
- Following the Safe Sanctuary Guidelines as adopted by Rose Hill United Methodist Church

Welcome to the newest family blessing!

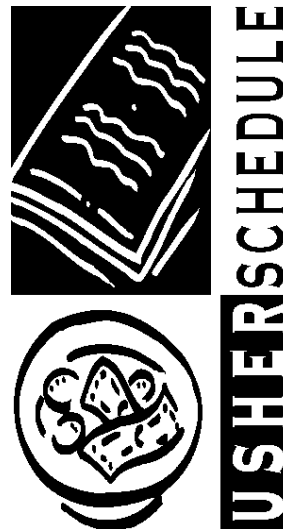
